

Emergency/Crisis Response

The Board of Trustees of the Pine Creek School Division recognizes the need to provide for both the physical and emotional safety needed by students, staff and parents in the event of a crisis or emergency situation.

A crisis is typically a sudden, powerful event that is outside the range of usual human experience. Crisis events have the potential to impact a school, more than one school or the entire school division. Examples of such crises include, but are not limited to, unexpected accidental deaths and injuries; crimes of violence; and natural and man-made disasters.

It is the intent of the Board that the school division shall have a Division Crisis Response Plan and School Crisis Plans in place to enact quick and effective responses in order to minimize the disastrous effects such crises can bring. It is also the intent of the Board that follow-up personal supports will be available to assist students, staff and parents with the long-term effects such crises often bring.
