In addressing these two conflicting values the Division has adopted the following procedures: The Board will consider dividing classrooms when informed that enrolments exceed the following numbers:

K-3 27 students 4 - 12 30 students

When enrolments fall below 10 students in any class the principal will inform the Superintendent. This will initially occur after course selections, by May 15th. Actual enrolments that fall below 10 students will be reported by September 15th. The Superintendent will inform the Board of the particular class and what the enrolment is. A decision regarding the continuation of the course or class will be made using the following criteria:

1. The actual number of students in the class.
2. Possible course or grade combinations to offer the program.
3. The need to offer the course to meet High-school graduation requirements.
4. The need to offer the course as related to post secondary entrance requirements.
5. The availability of alternate forms of delivery. ie) Independent study, Web based delivery etc.
6. The long-term projections for course enrolment.

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
