4. Instructions, Programs and Services - Administrative Procedure Manual

Individual Education Plans are written for students when:

- The student has exceptional learning needs requiring student specific outcomes that are additions to, different from, or exceed the curricular outcomes
- The students receives Special Needs Funding LII or III
- The student is determined to be eligible for the English as an Additional Language (E) designation, the Modified (M) course designation, or the Individualized Programming (I) designation in Grades 9 to 12.
