Suspensions

Suspension occurs when a student is removed from the classroom or dismissed from the school for a period of time. Any student who is removed from the classroom for a period of more than 80 minutes or is sent home is considered to be suspended, and the suspension process is to be followed.

Expulsions

Expulsions may be authorized only by the School Board and in accordance with the Public Schools Act.

Schools will offer and arrange alternative programming for students under the age of 18 who are expelled.

Student Expelled in another Jurisdiction

A student who has been expelled from schools in any school division jurisdiction shall not be admitted to any Pine Creek School until all the student's records have been received and a determination can be made regarding the appropriateness of that student's placement in a Pine Creek School. The school administration and superintendent shall make that determination.
