The Board of Trustees for the Pine Creek School Division is pleased to announce the pending appointment of its new Superintendent, Ms. Donna Miller Fry, B.Sc.(Hons), B.Ed., M.Ed., who will begin in her new role in the Division during July 2019.



For the past two years, Donna has served the families of Newfoundland and Labrador in the role of Assistant Director of Education. Prior to working in Newfoundland and Labrador, she was an Education Officer with the Curriculum and Assessment Policy Branch for the Ontario Ministry of Education, leading the Renewed Math Strategy in northern Ontario. Donna was the Ontario Lead for Leading Technology-Enabled Learning and Teaching, working with Superintendents and Directors to make good decisions around the procurement and use of technology to improve learning for all children, as well as serving as Project Lead for eLearning Ontario, Student Achievement Division. Prior to that experience, Donna worked over thirty years in publicly funded post-secondary and K-12 schools in Ontario as a teacher, administrative head, online instructor, alternative-education teacher, vice-principal, and principal.

Donna has a Master's Degree in Education Leadership and a post-graduate certificate in Change Leadership. She has completed the Supervisory Officers Qualifications and Principal Qualifications in Ontario. She is a member of the Advisory Council for the EdCan Network and has specialist qualifications in both special education and secondary school sciences, and spent five years at the Faculty of Education in Queen's University, teaching Additional Qualification courses for teachers in Technology Integration and Teaching and Learning through eLearning.
