The Pine Creek School Division Board of Trustees has regretfully accepted the resignation of Superintendent Ms. Donna Miller Fry, effective January 8, 2021.

Ms. Miller Fry has been recruited to take on an educational leadership position at the governmental level in another jurisdiction.

Since coming to PCSD eighteen months ago, Ms. Miller Fry has led the board to a deeper understanding of its role in divisional governance, guided the trustees through the process of updating the divisional strategic plan, and taken on the role of interim Secretary-Treasurer in addition to her duties as superintendent.

Ms. Miller Fry was instrumental in introducing mobile learning technologies in one of the first Edwin pilot projects in Manitoba, so that students from Grades 6 through 9 could access high-quality digital learning opportunities. She oversaw the redesigning of the management systems at the division office and created a highly desirable workplace in which employees could grow professionally.

Her leadership also produced increased provincial funding for the TMO program, through the introduction of podcasting projects and advocacy efforts with the Deputy Minister of Education and her team. To her credit, Ms. Miller Fry achieved all of this tremendous change while navigating an ever-changing landscape of hurdles brought about by Covid-19 and associated regulations and protocols.

The PCSD Board of Trustees wishes to thank Ms. Miller Fry for the outstanding leadership and the steadfast commitment she has shown to the students, staffs and communities she has served, as Superintendent of the Pine Creek School Division.

We wish her great satisfaction in her new position and the very best in all she undertakes.
