Students should be registered in a maximum of 5 courses per semester (including ISO, classroom, ITV, or other delivery methods).

- Grade 9 students – 5 compulsory credits and 3-4 optional credits. Recommended maximum is 8-10 credits per year.
- Grade 10 students – 5 compulsory credits and 2-4 optional credits. Recommended maximum is 7-9 credits per year.
- Grade 11 students – 4 compulsory credits and 2-4 optional credits. Recommended maximum is 7-8 credits per year.
- Grade 12 students – 3 compulsory credits and 1-2 optional credits. Recommended maximum is 5-7 credits per year.

Students require 30 Credits to graduate which include 17 Compulsory credits and a minimum of 13 Optional credits.
