A tobacco-free environment helps create a safe and healthy school and workplace. Smoking and secondhand smoke are known to cause serious lung diseases, heart disease and cancer. Pine Creek School division recognizes the hazards caused by tobacco use and exposure to secondhand tobacco smoke. Our policy to provide a tobacco-free environment for all students, employees and visitors is intended to keep a safe and healthy school and workplace environment. This policy covers the smoking of any tobacco product and the use of oral tobacco products, "spit" tobacco and e-cigarettes including e-cigarettes advertised as being either tobacco-free or as a smoking cessation product. The school division reserves the right to apply this policy to new products that the division, in its own judgment, deems to have an influence towards the use of tobacco products. This policy applies to students, employees and visitors to Pine Creek School Division schools and property.
