Thank you for your submission of an Expression of Interest to the School-Based Child Care Expansion Project. I am pleased to inform you that Plumas Elementary School has been selected to receive 70 new child care spaces.

The School-Based Child Care Expansion Project is an innovative approach to creating more child care spaces in partnership with school divisions in communities with a demonstrated need for child care. Through this project, Manitoba will provide full funding to develop new community-based child care spaces, in exchange for the school division's long-term lease to the child care operator, as well as serviced land (if required), grounds services and exterior building maintenance.

Funding for the project is provided through our partnership with Canada under the Canada-Manitoba Canada-Wide Early Learning and Child Care Agreement, and supports Manitoba's commitment to create 23,000 new child care spaces by 2026.
